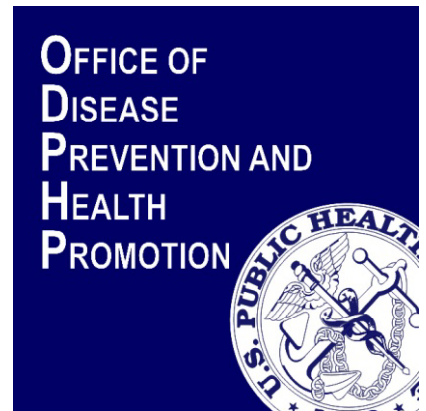

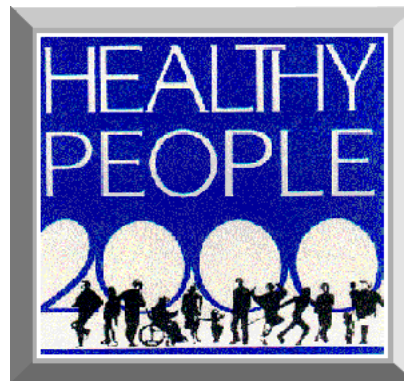

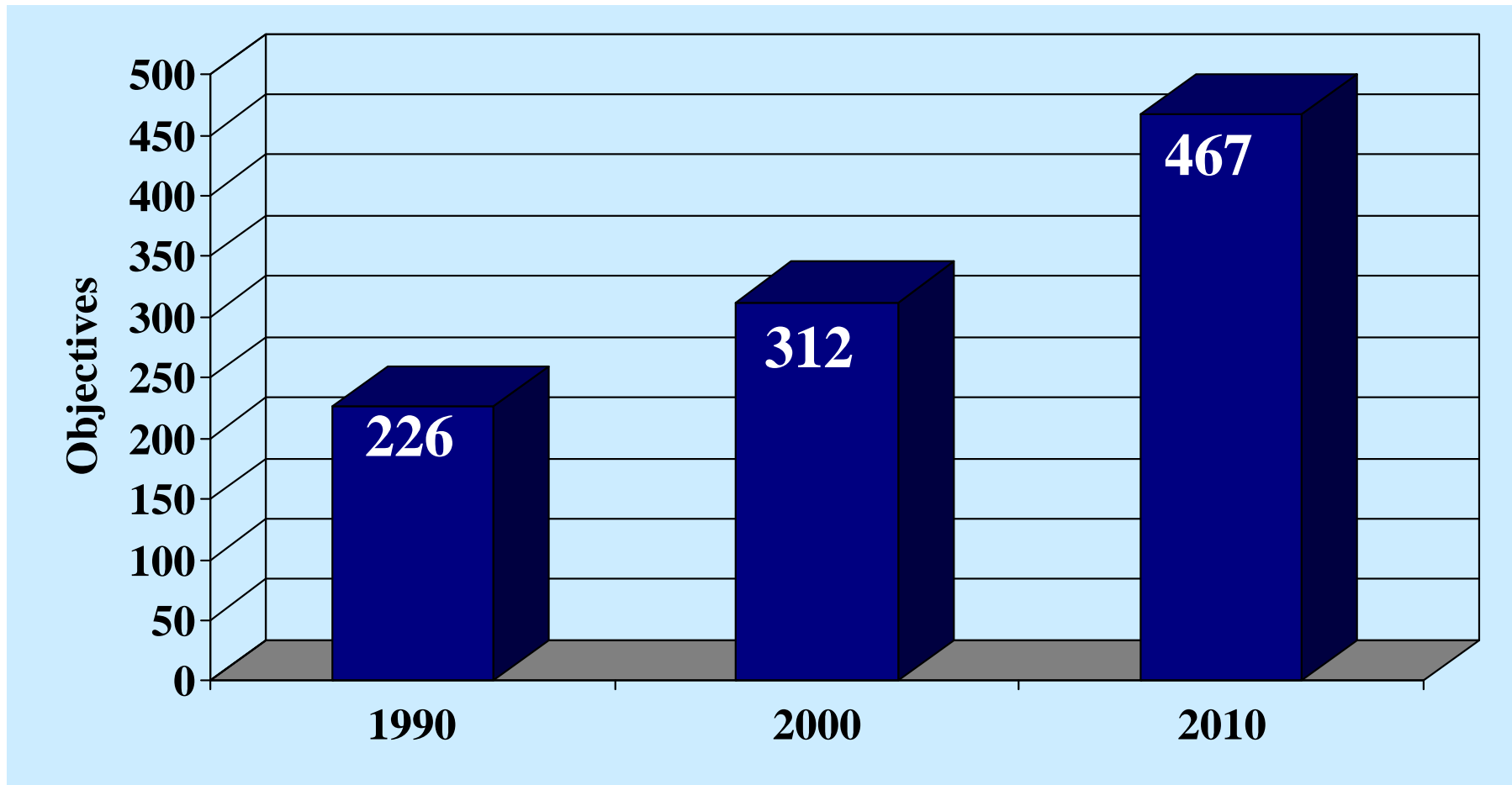
Healthy People: What is it?

- A framework for public health priorities and actions

Healthy People 2010: Strengths

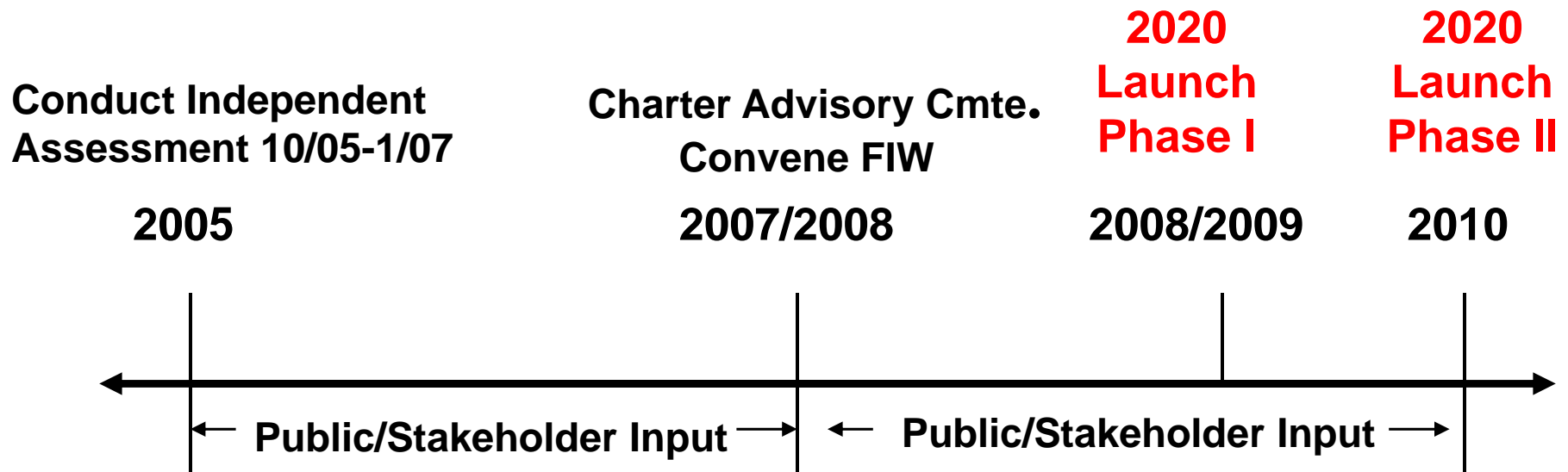
- Collaboration and Consensus
- Wide Array of Diverse Users
- Public Access to Data via Internet
- Science-Based and Evidence-Based
- Data-Driven
- Measurable Objectives With Targets



Healthy People 2010: Challenges

- Balancing between encyclopedic approach and targeted effort
- Integrating target setting across all areas
- Developing and funding of data sources
- Developing implementation plan
- Providing technical assistance

Healthy People 2020: Two-Phased Release

- 2007, 2008, 2009
 - Development of framework and overarching goals
 - Continued public input
- Late 2008, early 2009
 - Framework and overarching goals released
 - Begin development of objectives
 - Continued public input
- 2010
 - Final 2020 objectives released with baselines and targets



Healthy People 2020: Draft Organizing Framework

Focus areas

- Primary: Risk factors and determinants of health
- Secondary: Diseases and disorders
- Emphasis on Public Health Priorities
 - Health IT
 - Preparedness
 - Prevention

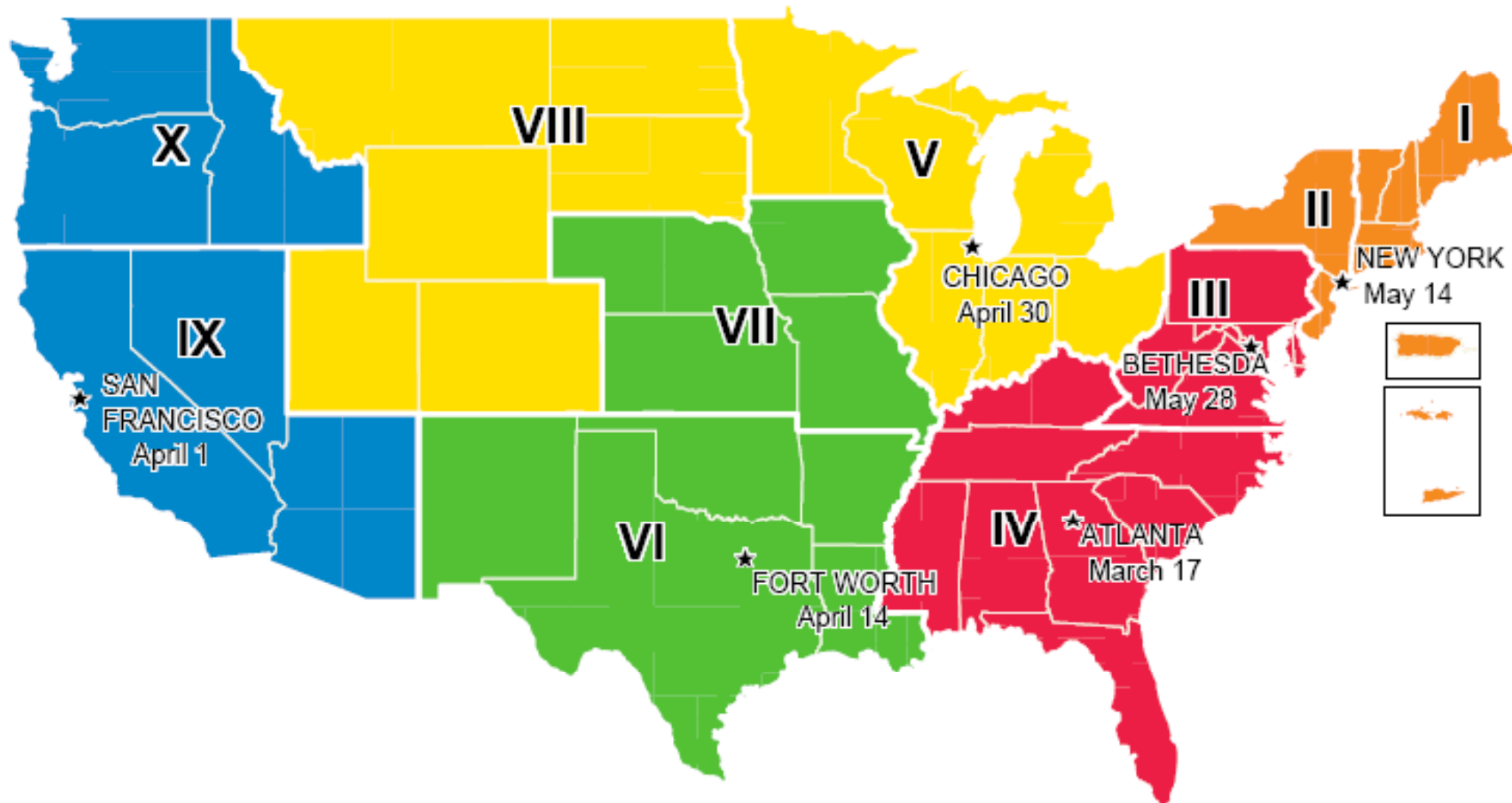

Region IX includes: American Samoa, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Guam, Marshall Islands, and the Republic of Palau



Healthy People 2020 comments

Comments generally supportive of a two-prong approach:
(risk factors/determinants; diseases/conditions)

- Risk factor approach benefits
 - Fosters collaboration across programs
 - More efficient approach by addressing a greater number of diseases
 - Helps move programs upstream
- Concerns with risk factor approach or reducing objectives/ disease topics
 - May impact disease/issue specific stakeholder buy-in and funding
 - Some diseases and vulnerable populations may be neglected

Healthy People: Federal Collaboration

- Federal Interagency Workgroup
 - Trans-federal membership
 - ~50 members, representing 23 HHS agencies/offices
 - Expand to include non-HHS Federal partners
 - DoEd, USDA, EPA, VA, DoJ, and others to come

- Vision
- Mission
- Overarching Goals
- Two-prong Organizing Framework



Healthy People 2020: Objectives/Targets

- Define processes for developing, evaluating, and narrowing objectives
- Significant Issues:
 - Number of objectives
 - Cost considerations
 - Ambitious or achievable target.
 - Surveillance of measures that have met their targets
 - Flexibility of objective selection and review processes to allow changes to objectives in order to match current scientific evidence

Next Steps

- Advisory Cmte. report finalized and submitted to Secretary Leavitt
- FIW report prepared for departmental clearance and subsequent submission to Secretary Leavitt
- HHS launches Healthy People 2020 Phase I in Dec 2008 or Jan 2009
- Initiate Phase II: Development of specific objectives
