

Larry L. Dickey, MD

Dr. Dickey has served as Chief of the Office of Clinical Preventive Medicine of the California Department of Health Services for the last 7 years. In this role he coordinates policy formulation and implementation efforts for a wide range of preventive medicine and public health issues and works closely with California's Medicaid program to improve the delivery of preventive services in practice. In addition, he serves as the Co-Chair for the Prevention Collaborative being conducted nationally in federally qualified health centers by the Bureau of Primary Health Care and the Institute for Healthcare Improvement.



Dr. Dickey is an Associate Adjunct Professor of Family and Community Medicine at the University of California, San Francisco where he is involved in teaching and research in the areas of preventive medicine, clinical ethics, and the foundations of patient care in the medical school curriculum. He has published multiple articles and book chapters on strategies to improve the delivery of preventive services in clinical practice through office system innovations and improved patient and provider education. He serves on the editorial boards of the *American Journal of Preventive Medicine* and *American Family Physician*.

During 1990-93, Dr. Dickey served as the APTR Luther Terry Fellow in Preventive Medicine in the U.S. Office of Disease Prevention and Health Promotion. In this role he worked with the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force and was involved in developing the Put Prevention Into Practice Program for the U.S. Public Health Service. As part of this effort Dr. Dickey served as the scientific editor and principal author for the first edition of the *Clinician's Handbook of Preventive Services*.

Dr. Dickey is a graduate of Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine and completed residencies in family practice and general preventive medicine at the University of California, San Francisco. He has master's degrees in public health and social work from the University of California, Berkeley.
